TOUCH Ireland Food Programmes

Over the last period TOUCH Ireland and TOUCH Zambia carried out four Food Programmes in Zambia. These were all at Community Schools Funded and built by TOUCH Ireland in very poor Compounds where children suffer greatly from poverty related diseases. Thanks to our friends on the ground in Zambia for their continued support.

At the best of times families living in very poor compounds struggle with the task of securing food for their families. At the moment in Zambia food is extremely scarce initially after a severe drought and then the rains came at the wrong time for the crops. This all resulted in failed crops across Zambia!
 A bag of Millie Meal which cost about 70K has gone up to 150K over double the normal price. (€1 = 13K approx.) Many of these families survive on a few Euros a day! However they struggle with Dignity to take care of their families!
